

On Thursday October 11th the Wiggins Police Department and Wiggins School District SRO were made aware of possible threats made toward students of the district. As every threat is taken seriously the two entities worked side by side.

A juvenile male student was taken into custody yesterday afternoon upon finding out that the child was threatening self harm and harm to some of his peers that attend Wiggins. The child openly told Wiggins P.D. and the Wiggins School District SRO that he planned to hurt a handful of individuals, including students at Wiggins. The juvenile was immediately taken into custody and will not be released to return to Wiggins

All parents of students who were mentioned as possible targets have been notified of the situation. Charges are pending and officers believe there is no threat to students or staff.
