*Mr. Kerr, Superintendent, reported that the school board attend the CASB Annual Convention. The board attended new board member sessions and breakout sessions to learn more about policy and finance. The assessed valuations of Adams, Morgan and Weld counties are approximately \$20 million less than last year. Blue Lightening ran cable to the new building.
